



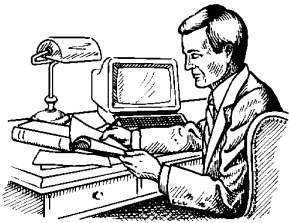

“Fair Booth Outreach”

There are many ways of doing the work of evangelism. I’ve always believed that the most effective efforts are through one on one relationships. Some have called this “Friendship Evangelism.” This doesn’t however mean that other methods are not needed and useful. For many decades our brotherhood was very effective in both Gospel Meetings and in door knocking outreaches. Through the years these methods may have lost some of their potency, at least in some communities, but they did illustrate that group efforts were both fun and very effective.

At Broad Street we’re hoping to find both of these last two phrases, fun and very effective, to be equally true of our upcoming outreach with the Fair Booth, September 21-26. The elders have approved the week long outreach and appropriated adequate funds to put very good teaching materials before the community. Furthermore, many of the church have been eager to sign up to work the shifts we’ve planned for Monday through Saturday from 5:30 - 10:00 P. M.

The exhibit booth will be located in the commercial exhibits section of the fair grounds. We’ll have an 8' x 12' area set up attractively in which we feature several methods of teaching. A video of the “Searching For Truth” five-lesson series will be in continuous play mode as we offer the series on dvd, vhs, or by a church member bringing the lessons into the home of those who would like to register for one.

Additionally, we will be giving away “Way of Salvation” marked New Testaments to all our visitors, plus an assortment of teaching tracts and study aids. Visitors will have the opportunity to register for the Bible Correspondence Course in the World Bible School Series, and request the dvd lessons, a visit by a church member, plus place their name in the drawing for a beautiful Thompson Chain Reference Study Bible in the New King James version, all on one form.

A special feature has been added where visitors will be directed to a page on our Internet site discussing matters of salvation which also links them to our entire web page which is full of church information, sermons, bulletin articles, and links to numerous Bible study locations.

Pray for the success of this outreach in finding precious souls who are searching for salvation.
