### **“2014 - Looking Ahead: A Work To Be Done”**

Nearly 2000 years after Christ gave the Great Commission, Christianity remains a minority religion in the world. I've heard missionaries – especially in the Far-East, in cities of millions of people – tell of seeing giant Coca-Cola signs, yet many have never heard of Jesus of Nazareth in these same cities. The Beatles were more correct than we cared to admit back in the 60's when they claimed to be more popular than Jesus Christ.

Friends, we have a Twenty-First Century world to be won!!! The task before us is enormous! In 2014 we have reached a world population at **7.2 Billion** people. The death rate in the U.S. is 2,162,000 per year; that's one every 15 seconds!! Hundreds are dying every second around the world!!! It's been estimated that **Churches of Christ in the United States** number approximately 1.5 million members in some **13,000+ congregations**. An outdated report from World Missions published by Abilene Christian University in 1991 indicated that there were **2,235,013 members of the church in 36,942 congregations** of the church in 224 countries world wide. The sobering question of the hour is, “If we don't win these people to Christ, who will?”

I sometimes wonder what the Lord must think of us. Here we are in the land of freedom, with every convenience at our disposal. We say we are dedicated to the propagation of simple, nondenominational New Testament Christianity, and yet the combined efforts that are put forth are only a small fraction of the effort in teaching the simple truth of Christ that other world groups are willing to devote in teaching error.

Jesus parted with the urgent words of **Matt. 28:19-20**, “*Go...Teach....Baptizing....Teach them to continue....*” These words set in motion a plan that, if diligently followed, could assure that His coming, His work, His death, burial and resurrection would not be in vain, but every man would know His grace, and mercy, and have opportunity to obey Him and serve Him. **He's counting on us!**

The church of Christ is not just a saved fraternity---We have a reason for being the church of our Lord. Our existence is for a mission just as Christ's life had a mission:– “*As thou didst send me into the world, even so sent I them into the world*” (**John 17:18** ). We have a mission, a sending into our times with a message to make known “*the manifold wisdom of God, according to the eternal purpose which he purposed in Christ Jesus our Lord.*” (**Eph. 3:10**). Here is the beginning and the end of why the church came into being at God's command, certainly not just to be a saved fraternity, but to carry out the “*ministry of reconciliation*” (**2 Cor. 5:18-21**).

A church that is not “mission- minded” has lost sight of her reason for existing. Let there be no mistake about it, **IF THE CHURCH FAILS IN HER MISSION, THE WORLD DIES LOST!! IF THIS GENERATION IS BROUGHT TO CHRIST, THIS GENERATION MUST BRING THEM!**

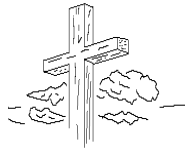

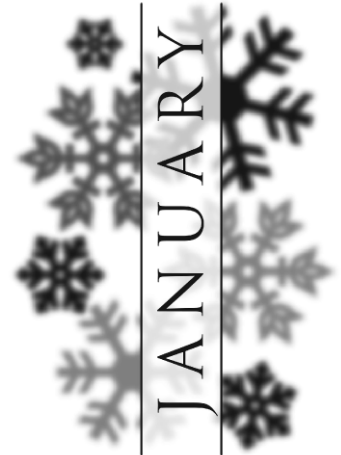
