### **“Happy Birthday! Broad Street -- 130 Years Old!!!**

In January, 1884, James A. Harding, an evangelist from Kentucky and co-founder of Nashville Bible School, now known as David Lipscomb University, held the first known Gospel meeting in Scottsboro, Alabama. This was at the request of Dr. Jack Rorex, a dentist who was an early member of the Stevenson church of Christ. Bro. Rorex requested through **THE GOSPEL ADVOCATE** that a preacher come to conduct a gospel meeting in Scottsboro. Bro. Harding answered that call and held this first meeting, during which eight to ten persons became Christians. The services during this meeting were held in the Missionary Baptist church building. Later that same year, J. W. Shepherd of Kentucky conducted a second Gospel meeting. At some point following this meeting, a church building was erected on Peachtree Street just off the Courthouse Square.

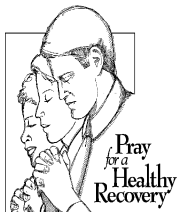
In several newspaper articles dated in the year 1886 and others continuing until some time in the early 1900's, editors referred to the church as the “Christian Church.” This was at a time during restoration history when the name had been used almost interchangeably with “church of christ,” but due to the instrumental music question, most churches who were not in favor of mechanical instruments began using this latter term. When J. M. Gainer became minister here, he changed church announcements in the newspapers to read “the church of Christ.”

This interesting quote from “**The Jackson County Christian**” brings us to our present location: “The congregation at Scottsboro has just purchased a \$2,500 lot on which to erect a new building in the near future. The lot is located on the corner of Broad Street and Charlotte Avenue. The purchase was made from brother W. J. Derrick of the Scottsboro congregation.” (“Jackson County Christian,” July 1945, Charles E. Cobb, editor.) **The new brick church building was completed in 1950.** The cost of this new facility was between \$38,000 and \$40,000. The first service in this building was conducted September 3, 1950. Jack Wilhelm was the minister and the singing was under the capable direction of Wendell Page.

In 1955, a new seven-room minister’s house was built on an adjoining lot just north of the church building. It was first occupied by Lindsay Allen and family. Succeeding preachers who lived in the house at that location were Paul Kidwell, W. A. Black, Robert Buchanan and Charles E. Cobb and their families. In April 1967, the house was moved from Broad Street to 406 Charlotte Avenue to make room for the construction of an addition to the building. This annex was completed in September 1968 at an approximate cost of \$65,000. The new section added a seating capacity of approximately 200.

On Sunday, July 23, 1978, a ground-breaking ceremony was held for an extensive renovation of the church building. In April 1979, the \$600,000 building project was complete with the construction of a new auditorium, presently in use. The first service in the new auditorium was conducted Sunday, April 15, 1979. A record attendance was set for morning worship with 610 present. Members of the building committee were Tommy Bellomy, Bill Covan, Grady Dawson, Leroy Gist, Mac Kennamer and Ralph Sheppard. **Vision and faith have brought us to this moment 130 years later. May this church serve God faithfully until the Lord’s return!!!**

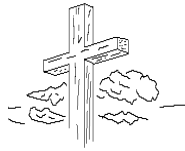
