From Where I Sit . . .

The Broad Street Church of Christ in Scottsboro is celebrating their 136th year of continuous existence with a

special day of activities on Sunday February 23.

The church was started in Scottsboro in 1884 by Dr. Jack Rorex, a dentist, who was one of the earlier members of the Stevenson Church of Christ, Dr. Rorex made an appeal through the Gospel Advocate Magazine published in Nashville, TN for a minister to come and conduct a gospel meeting. James A. Harding, co-founder of David Lipscomb University, Nashville, TN, answered the appeal; and in January of 1884, the first service was held. In the latter part of that year, J. W. Sheppard, of Kentucky, conducted a second meeting. church has been here continuously since January, 1884.



In 1886 the first building was erected just off the square on Peachtree Street. James A. Harding was the first minister. In 1950 a new building was erected on the corner of Broad and Charlotte. This building went through several expansions over the years, and in April of 1979, the last renovation of the building was completed.

Among the ministers who have preached for this congregation in the past are James A. Harding, A. B. Lipscomb, W. R. Craig, G. L. Mann, Jack Wilhelm, Lindsay Allen, Paul Kidwell, Sr., W. A. Black, Charles Cobb, Charles Curtis, Butch Foster, and Johnny Mack Young. Our present minister since 2002 is Terry Broome.

On Sunday February 23, in addition to morning classes at 9 AM and worship at 10 AM, there will be a potluck lunch followed by a 1:00 Afternoon Worship Service. At 2:00 we will host an area-wide Gospel Singing. We would love for our many friends in and around Scottsboro to join us especially for the 1:00 service and the 2:00 singing. We hope you will come and sing with us praises to God!!
