### “Let the Redeemed of the Lord Say So”

The Apostle Paul tells us that the main-line business of the church is to “**Make known the manifold wisdom of God**”(Eph. 3:10). We have two avenues through which we can do this – by living faithful Christian lives and through the avenue of teaching and preaching. All Christians can and should be involved in this work. Notice Acts 8:4 – “**Therefore they that were scattered abroad went everywhere preaching the word.**” These were not all preachers in the formal sense, but faithful Christians with a passion.

We must remember that the work of preaching and teaching was part of God’s Plan. It is in fact a necessary work in our times!! Current population figures vividly demonstrate the great need for dedicated gospel preachers and Bible teachers. We have a great challenge before us! The world population has grown to an estimated 7.8 Billion People compared to 2.8 Billion in 1948 when I was born. Those who accept this challenge will truly have to be “lovers of God” and “lovers of teaching and preaching” in order to survive!

Jeremiah the prophet has been called the “weeping prophet.” He suffered tremendous hardship as God’s spokesman in Judah during the Babylonian captivity. His hardship was so great that at one point he simply wanted to give up. Notice his dilemma. He wanted to give up, yet he had a passion for God’s word. **Jeremiah 20:9 (ESV)** *“Then I said, I will not make mention of him, nor speak any more in his name. But his word was in mine heart as a burning fire shut up in my bones, and I was weary with holding it in, and I cannot.”* Jeremiah’s language paints a vivid picture of the intensity of passion he felt for God’s word. That passion is needed today in a world where persecution is growing more and more likely to result. We need to feel so deeply about spreading the Gospel that we simply have to tell others about God’s love and saving Grace regardless of the consequence!

When the son of God entered the scene to make known the Father's Will, He “**...came into Galilee, preaching the gospel of God...**” (Mk. 1:14). It’s noteworthy that God had but one son, and He made him a preacher. Are there any parents today that would deliberately point their sons toward ministry? Perhaps there are some. Take heart, ministers do not have to stand alone. Faithful Christians have much of the same responsibility. **1 Corinthians 3:9 (KJV)** *“For we are labourers together with God: ye are God's husbandry, ye are God's building.”* Jeremiah was pretty much alone except that God was with him. We have God, and each other today.

Man’s acute need today is the saving Word of God. **James 1:21** *“Wherefore lay apart all filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness, and receive with meekness the engrafted word, which is able to save your souls.”*

Furthermore, man is in need of the purifying, incorruptible seed which is the Word Of God. **1 Peter 1:22-23** *“Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently: Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth forever.”*

If you have a passion for telling others about God’s saving grace, then in the words of **Psalm 107:2** *“Let the redeemed of the LORD say so...”* We must all stand together and offer hope to a dying world.

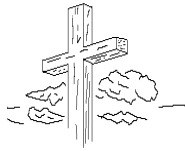

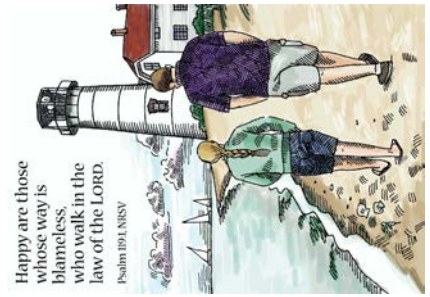
