Deep Appreciation For Your Expressions Of Love

Brotherly love is a precious benefit that comes from being associated with God's people. Words that come to my mind today for the Broad Street church family come straight from Peter's writing in **1 Peter 3:8 (NIV)** ⁸ **"Finally, all of you, live in harmony with one another; be sympathetic, love as brothers, be compassionate and humble."** These words ring sweet music in my heart as I look back over the past years together with our family at Broad Street Church of Christ. You've been there for us through so many hard times over those years.

These past five weeks have been very traumatic in the Broome family's life. Ministers are not immune from their own heartache and losses. I feel your pain with each crisis you have to face, and you have manifested that same toward us. In September we suddenly lost the middle of my 3 younger brothers in an untimely way. Within days after returning home from his funeral, Kathy and I became quarantined having tested positive for the COVID virus. We were confined for two weeks, but we are cleared to be in public. During this quarantine my father came down with a critical and terminal case of COVID Pneumonia. I was not able to help him from afar, having been quarantined. He died one day short of a month after my brother's death. During this same time I was not able to minister to the family of our dear Sister Glenda Moore and I could not do her funeral when asked. We are only small dots on a map of the heartache that people world-wide are feeling during 2020 and COVID-19 Pandemic. May God provide deliverance.

The hundreds of written text messages, sympathy and get-well cards, phone calls, food offers, all remind us that we are with the finest people on God's green earth. These, plus the gift of the "Memory Chime" at my brother's passing, and the beautiful Fall wreath at my dad's passing are so greatly appreciated. Kathy and I love each one of you. Thank you for loving us!

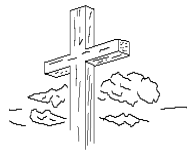
