A Tribute to Our Friend, Dr. Jack Zorn

Churches Have Struggled for Years with the Questions: “How can we retain our young people---and our new converts?” “How can we prepare them for the challenges they must face in the church tomorrow?” Many good programs emerged as the youth of the Lord’s family became the target of massive efforts among leadership. One such program is the LADS TO LEADERS AND LEADERETTES Leadership Training program--now in its 53rd year of operation.

Dr. Jack Zorn had the vision to meet one of the greatest needs of our brotherhood, tapping the rich natural resources of our very own youth!! This Program is designed to prepare boys and girls for leadership in the church. From a very humble beginning with Dr. Zorn and a small room of boys in 1968 in Warner Robins, GA., he began with just a training class in how to give speeches. Lads to Leaders has emerged from his tireless efforts to be a nation-wide, and international, yet locally operated, program of training for young people in the church to become leaders within the country, home, and church. Hundreds of congregations throughout our brotherhood utilize this teaching and developmental method. Over 20,000 students and adult sponsors attend the annual National Convention held each year on Easter weekend. Broad Street first got involved in September of 2003 and attended our first Convention Easter weekend of 2004.

It is with sadness in my heart I share with you that Bro. Zorn has passed away on Thursday, August 12. He was a friend to the parents and children within congregations all over America, and my personal friend for the past 60 years since I was 13 years old. A Memorial Service honoring Bro. Zorn will be conducted in Montgomery at the University Church on Saturday, August 28.

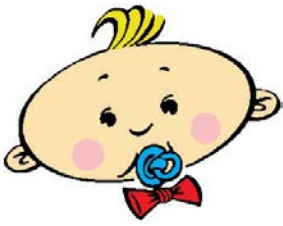

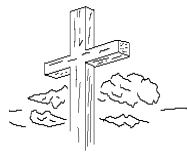
