### **“Your Relation to Church Growth”**

You are an important link as to why people become members in a local congregation.

**Reasons people most often give for choosing a particular congregation are:**

- Friendly, warm, positive atmosphere. This ingredient is most in-common with all churches.
- Bible classes.
- Wide range of activities and opportunities for involvement.
- Faith and Leadership of the church leaders.
- Deacons and Ministry leaders actively pursuing ministry systems.

#### **Major reasons why people DO NOT drop out:**

- They're involved; Committed; They love God; Sense of Fellowship; They see an end result;
- Friends; Needs being met by existing programs; Sense of Belonging; Meets the needs of others.

#### **Special Needs of New Christians:**

- Special emphasis on follow-up fellowship;
- They need close friends
- Need a sense of belonging. (Too many feel like outsiders far too long. We must make them feel welcome and significant.)
- Need meaningful involvement, and immediately;
- Need much love and encouragement. (Note how much attention we give new babies. Let's act the same toward new babes in Christ.)
- They need Christian teaching, patiently but firmly administered.
  - Positive and strong example;
  - Pairing with family older in the faith;
  - Fill the vacuum created when they left the world, or worldliness will return.

There's much that you and I can do to strengthen members within the local congregation. Much of what is listed above for new Christians is equally applicable to those who have been in the church for years. People need to be needed, and love to feel wanted.

One very important ingredient to church growth is to remember that “I AM my brother's keeper.” We need to keep our eyes and ears open to signals that someone may be discouraged and need special attention. Furthermore, we need to put forth a voluntary effort to reach out to these ones even if no one has “assigned” them to us. We go because we care, not because we are “assigned” to. Broad Street Church of Christ has great potential, but we all must accept responsibility of helping fulfill that greatness. God bless us in this undertaking.

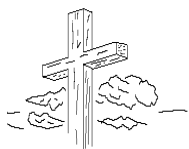
However, let me ask you a few more:

- Have you ever prayed so personally to GOD that you cried and tried to let Him have all your problems because you finally realized you can't do it without Him?

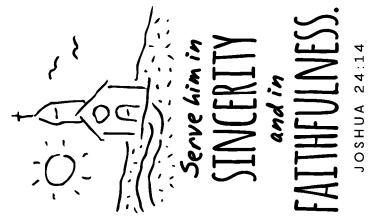
