Sunday, April 30, 2023, marks the conclusion of our 21 years together in the capacity of being your Minister's family. After 54½ years of full time ministry, and 3 years as a fill-in preacher, I've decided that I'm ready to retire from the full time role. I hope to continue

This decision was not made hastily. I always felt like I would know when it was time to change the pace. Over the last two years and in much prayer, it seems that this is that time. From our hearts to yours, we truly love each of you. Our lives have been blessed richly for having this time together.

We've shared in experiences involving Births, Life, and Death together. We've shared in New Births of those who became Christians, and the heart aches of those fallen away, as well as the scores who moved on to other cities. We've experienced weddings, graduations, promotions, and much more. These have all been a part of our fellowship with each other, our Christian family. We did it together!

To me, preaching isn't a job but a calling – a way of life. I was not your preacher as a job. My work with you has been a passion. We were family, God's Family. We prayed together, laughed together, and we cried together.

We lived together through some bumpy history in the world, and in the Lord's church in America. Yet we held the compass to the Book of God and never strayed. Your pulpit evangelist and your Elders were 100% united on our conviction and stand for the Truths of God.

God placed the office of Elder in the church, and I respect that office very highly. They have upheld me as a Gospel preacher, or I could not have been allowed to speak from this pulpit for the past 21 years. For that I am most grateful.

I had the personal privilege and pleasure of delivering approximately 1900 sermons and offering some 2800 invitations at Broad Street during these 21 years. Many souls were added to the Kingdom. I have never thought or felt that the successes were mine or the Elders. These are the Lord's successes. May He continue to give us victories that we do not deserve, for this is His Kingdom, and all of us are just servants – "unprofitable servants" (Luke 17:10) even after attempting to do all that He has commanded us.

Thank you for your patience over any of my shortcomings. From 21 years ago, the love demonstrated by Sister Louise Romans on the first Sunday we visited here by her asking us to sit with her on pew number 5, unto the many cards you showered us with through the years in times of sickness, and the deaths of our loved ones, we have felt most loved. From our hearts to yours, we truly love each one of you! Our emotions are taut, yet our hearts are full of anticipation: (Acts 21:14) "The will of the Lord be done."
