Be Like a Tree

Have you ever had a jawbreaker that was all different colors throughout? I don't understand why people liked jawbreakers so much, especially the really big ones you can't fit in your mouth. I guess it's just because of the challenge or shock of how big they are. I do think it's neat that if you break into them, you can see all the different layers. It reminds me of a 100 year old tree, but the layers are colorful and distinct. Have you ever looked at the growth of a 100 year old tree and seen the difference in size between the good years and the bad? The good years may be a lot of growth and very healthy. The bad years are lean and maybe even scars in the layers from trauma.

What if we could open your life up and distinguish between experiences and years that you've lived? What if the years of your life were only as big as you grew spiritually each year? Would you have a lot of big growth years or would you look like a tree that never gets watered and barely made it most of it's life?

We think about our life in terms of physical maturity, wealth, jobs, marriage, possessions, and family. However, what really matters is what we look like when you examine us from the inside out, like a colorful jawbreaker or a 100 year old tree. Our spiritual life can't always be seen by others and isn't even thought of sometimes by us, but it's the most important aspect of us. How are we growing in the LORD and are we looking more and more like JESUS every day or do we look like last years holiday tree that never got watered?
