### **“DEDICATED TO WORSHIP”**

One of the most obvious ways to see a person’s dedication to Christ is through worship. A story is told of a preacher who had become greatly disturbed over a member of his congregation who had quit coming to the worship services. The member was sorely missed by the congregation and by the preacher himself. The preacher decided to visit this wayward brother. He found the brother sitting by an open fire in his house. The brother brought a chair for the preacher to sit in and braced himself for the expected rebuke he thought might follow. Instead not a word did the preacher say. He simply reached into the fire with some tongs and took out a single glowing ember. He sat the red glowing ember of coal on the cold hearth. Remaining painfully silent, they watched the glowing ember slowly become cold and eventually die out. The absentee brother broke the silence, “You don’t need to say a word, preacher. I’ll be there at the next service where I belong.”

As the temperatures begin to soar around us, we seem to be actively involved pursuing more and more things that can pull us away from our dedication to worship God. Jesus made it very clear and very plain that worship is not an option if we want to be pleasing to God, **John 4: 23 - 24** “[23] **“But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him. [24] “God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth.”** Worship not only pleases God, but it does some very important things for us also. Take a good look at **Hebrews 10: 19 - 25**, “[19] **Therefore, brethren, having boldness to enter the Holiest by the blood of Jesus, [20] by a new and living way which He consecrated for us, through the veil, that is, His flesh, [21] and having a High Priest over the house of God, [22] let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water. [23] Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful. [24] And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works, [25] not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as is the manner of some, but exhorting one another, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching.”** Worship brings us to the holiest place on earth where the saints of God are gathered with God in their very presence. Worship brings us into commune with God as we remember and celebrate the death, the burial and the resurrection of Jesus Christ and we remember that He is coming back. Worship is a time to profess our faith in God with others who have the same faith. Worship is a time of encouragement to continue to do the work God requires his children to do.

If you travel or you find yourself so busy this summer from activities that demand so much time, do not forget to worship God. None of us wants our ember to grow cold and die.
