From Where I Sit . . .

"TO BE LIKE JESUS"

There is a thing that is very popular now that you may see often in different places. I have seen it at sporting events, on billboards, and on bus benches. It is a thing called, "Jesus Gets Us". This is a very obvious statement since Jesus created us and that we were created for Him, Colossians 1: 15 - 18, "[15] He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. [16] For by Himall things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him. [17] And He is before all things, and in Himall things consist. [18] And He is the head of the body, the church, who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in all things He may have the preeminence." As I am thinking about this, I wonder if the message they are trying to send to us is Jesus is just like us, so He gets us. To think this way brings Jesus to our level of being the creature instead of the Creator. It is true Jesus gets us, but His coming to us was to take us as we are and to transform us into who He is. When I think about this I think about Matthew 9: 35 - 38, "[35] Then Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people. [36] But when He saw the multitudes, He was moved with compassion for them, because they were weary and scattered, like sheep having no shepherd. [37] Then He said to His disciples, "The harvest truly is plentiful, but the laborers are few. [38] "Therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest." This passage tells us a lot about how Jesus conducted His life while He was on this earth.

Jesus came to leave with us an example of how we should live if we are going to transform ourselves into His image. If we are going to transform our lives into the very likeness of Jesus, we must begin to live as He lived. Three things immediately come to my mind when I think of this Matthew Chapter Nine passage. First, if we are going to live like Jesus, we must begin to see like Jesus. Jesus saw a world that was filled with pain and suffering, He saw a world that needed something it did not have, and He sawa world that lacked a relationship with God. Jesus came to bring us what would stop the hurting, that would fill the void that was need, and to restore the relationship with God that had been broken. He came to bring Us the good news of the gospel so that we could be healed, so we could have what was missing in our lives and to reconcile us to God, Romans 5: 6 - 11, [6] For when we were still without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly. [7] For scarcely for a righteous man will one die; yet perhaps for a good man someone would even dare to die. [8] But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. [9] Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him. [10] For if when we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life. [11] And not only that, but we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received the reconciliation." Secondly, we need to feel as Jesus felt. Jesus was moved with compassion for those who lacked these things enough to do all He could do to bring to us what we needed, Philippians 2: 5 - 8, "[5] Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, [6] who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, [7] but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men. [8] And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross." Thirdly, we need to pray like Jesus prayed. Jesus prayed that others would become like Him so they could help meet these needs that He saw and that He felt.

It is true that "Jesus Gets Us". He gets us in that we need a way to escape the lives we have in this world to become a child of God like He is. Jesus prayed for this in John 17: 20 - 23, "[20] "I do not pray for these alone, but also for those who will believe in Me through their word; [21] "that they all may be one, as You, Father, are in Me, and I in You; that they also may be one in Us, that the world may believe that You sent Me. [22] "And the glory which You gave Me I have given them, that they may be one just as We are one: [23] "I in them, and You in Me; that they may be made perfect in one, and that the world may know that You have sent Me, and have loved them as You have loved Me." Are we doing all we can to make this a reality in our lives?
