# From Where I Sit... "HAVE YOU MADE YOUR NEW YEAR'S RESOLUTIONS?"

I am sitting at my desk thinking about the coming New Year. I am thinking about all the things I hope to accomplish in this New Year. As I think about this I have to admit that I am feeling a bit overwhelmed. I know that this probably doesn't happen to you. So I guess what I am trying to do is somehow narrow this down to some simple principles that might be able to guide me that would cover all that I want to accomplish. Principles that will allow me to concentrate on the truly most important things that need to be done.

There is no better place to begin than with the greatest commandments, Matthew 22: 37 - 40, "[37] Jesus said to him, "'You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.' [38] "This is the first and great commandment. [39] "And the second is like it: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' [40] "On these two commandments hang all the Law and the Prophets." Jesus tells us that to have the best year ever it must begin by loving God. How are we to do this? It begins by having a sense of highly valuing God above all things. Our teens and some adults wear a bracelet that says, "What Would Jesus Do?" The idea is that we take Jesus in consideration before taking any action in our lives. But highly valuing God goes much deeper than this. It means we highly value a relationship with God over all other relationships. Remember what Jesus said in Matthew 10: 37, "[37] "He who loves father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me. And he who loves son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me." Even the closest of human relationships cannot come before our relationship with God. It also means that we highly value His words. The teachings of God found in His word must become more important that any other teaching we might have had. It means we must spend more time learning the lessons He has for us in His word than we spend learning any other lessons we might learn in this life, Il Timothy 2: 15 - 16, "[15] Be diligent to present yourself approved to God, a worker who does not need to be as hamed, rightly dividing the word of truth. [16] But shun profane and idle babblings, for they will increase to more ungodliness." It also means we will value our allegiance to God more than any other allegiance we might have whether that be work, or clubs, or teams or even the country that we live in. We demonstrate this allegiance through our obedience and through our service to God, Romans 6: 16 - 18, "[16] Do you not know that to whom you present yourselves slaves to obey, you are that one's slaves whom you obey, whether of sin leading to death, or of obedience leading to righteousness? [17] But God be thanked that though you were slaves of sin, yet you obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine to which you were delivered. [18] And having been set free from sin, you became slaves of righteousness."

This love of God also means that we should always have God's best interest at heart for this is a part of the definition of love. What is God's best interest? This one is easy, it is simply His creation, us. We are what God is interested in and He has done all things for us. What does God want for us? He wants us to be with Him throughout eternity and to share in all that He has. We must insure this comes true for our lives by following the advice Paul gave to the Philippians, Philippians 2: 12 - 13, "[12] Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling; [13] for it is God who works in you both to will and to do for His good pleasure." We also do this by helping others come to be disciples of Christ, Matthew 28: 19 - 20, "[19] "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, [20] "teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and Io, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." In order to have a great year, we simply must spend it seek the right things. I hope we all have the best year ever.
