From Where I Sit . . .

"LITTLE THINGS MATTER"

Charles Shulz paints an interesting perspective about life in his "Peanut" comic strip. Charlie Brown is seen at bat. Strike Three! He says, "Rats, I'll never be a big

league player. I just don't have it! All my life I've dreamed of playing in the big leagues, but I know I'll never make it." Lucy turns to console him. "Charlie Brown", she says, "You're thinking too far ahead. What you need to do is set some immediate goals. Start with the next inning, when you go out to pitch. See if you can walk to the mound without falling down!" I do not think we need too many friends like Lucy to give us advice, but she does make a valid point.

We do often set our sights so far ahead that we often lose sight of what is in front of us. We also set our sights on the grand things of this Christian life and we miss the opportunities we have that are right in front of us. We get so wrapped up in trying to find grand things to do in order to demonstrate our grand faith in Christ that we overlook the small simple opportunities we have to demonstrate Christ living in us on a daily basis. Isn't this the simple message of the judgment scene we see Jesus describe in Matthew 25: 34 - 40, "[34] "Then the King will say to those on His right hand, 'Come, you blessed of My Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world: [35] for I was hungry and you gave Me food; I was thirsty and you gave Me drink; I was a stranger and you took Me in; [36] 'I was naked and you clothed Me; I was sick and you visited Me; I was in prison and you came to Me.' [37] "Then the righteous will answer Him, saying, 'Lord, when did we see You hungry and feed You, or thirsty and give You drink? [38] 'When did we see You a stranger and take You in, or naked and clothe You? [39] 'Or when did we see You sick, or in prison, and come to You?' [40] "And the King will answer and say to them, 'Assuredly, I say to you, inasmuch as you did it to one of the least of these My brethren, you did it to Me."We can get caught up waiting for that grand thing to come along that we miss the simple things we can do for others on a day-to-day basis. Christianity is about allowing Jesus to transform us into His very image. One of the greatest descriptions of Jesus can be found as Peter is teaching Cornelius and his family about the Beloved Son Of God, Acts 10: 38, "[38] "how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him." Jesus the one that we are trying to emulate simply went about doing good. Sure He was going to do some grand things like die on a cross, be buried in a tomb, and be resurrected on the third day, but He never lost sight on taking advantage of the opportunities that were before Him every day. He simpy did the little things while waiting for the grand things to come along.

Maybe we should keep our vision on the present. Maybe we should focus our attention on the small opportunities we have everyday. This will keep us from tripping and falling as we wait for grand things to come our way.
