From Where I Sit . . .

“SEARCH FOR TREASURE”

Most of us as a child have dreamed of finding buried treasure. You have seen children with their buckets and small shovels digging in the earth or in the sands of the beach. They work so hard hoping to find this allusive buried treasure. These little guys will work even harder when they have been spurred on by tales of some ole crusty pirate like Black Beard. We are fascinated by their endless imaginations and the lengths and the effort they will go to find this treasure. Children believe so very quickly and they will begin their search immediately. They will quickly put their focus and their intent on finding the treasure they are seeking. They will also use whatever tools are available to them to help them discover this unseen treasure.

Jesus has told us that the way to the unseen everlasting treasure of eternal life is found in His Word. Do we believe these words? If we truly believed this with the belief of a small child, we would find ourselves searching diligently within the Word of God to find this marvelous treasure. Solomon wrote about this treasure in Proverbs 2: 1 - 5, “[2:1] My son, if you receive my words, And treasure my commands within you, 2] So that you incline your ear to wisdom, And apply your heart to understanding; [3] Yes, if you cry out for discernment, And lift up your voice for understanding, 4] If you seek her as silver, And search for her as for hidden treasures; [5] Then you will understand the fear of the LORD, And find the knowledge of God.” We are to seek this treasure like little children, Mark 10: 13 - 16, “[13] Then they brought little children to Him, that He might touch them; but the disciples rebuked those who brought them. [14] But when Jesus saw it, He was greatly displeased and said to them, “Let the little children come to Me, and do not forbid them; for of such is the kingdom of God. [15] “Assuredly, I say to you, whoever does not receive the kingdom of God as a little child will by no means enter it.” [16] And He took them up in His arms, laid His hands on them, and blessed them.” This passage reminds us that as little children we must believe the Word; we must seek the treasure hidden within the Word with focus, intent, and hard work; and we must use whatever tools are available to us to insure we receive this marvelous treasure.

We might need to ask ourselves some important questions. Do we quickly receive and believe the Word of God? Do we seek its divine instructions as if it is a hidden treasure that we desire? Do we pursue the Word of God as a child pursues buried treasure? Maybe we need to dust off our Bibles and begin to dig deeply into the Word of God with a child-like enthusiasm that we use to have when we believed and pursue buried treasure.

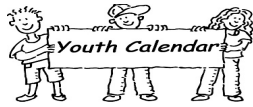

Broad Street welcomes our new brother and sister in Christ, Christian Lemaster and Lana Jones

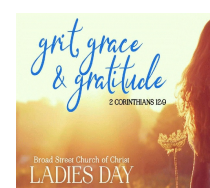

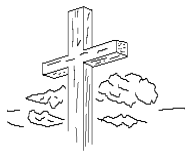
