From Where I Sit . . .

“GOD DESIRES A STEADFAST HEART”

I truly love to read the Psalms. Reading the Psalms allows me to see a fellow human being, who has favor with God, but is struggling with the issues of life. We see David, the man after God’s own heart, cry out to the Lord during these ever present struggles in his own personal life. Even in the midst of these struggles David does not lose sight of the importance of having a steadfast heart. Notice the words of Psalms 57: 7, “[7] *My heart is steadfast, O God, my heart is steadfast; I will sing and give praise.*” No matter what the uproar that is taking place in his personal life, David realizes that God wants him to have a steadfast heart that hold steady and that this steadfast heart will lead him to have a steadfast worship of God.

The question then becomes, how do I develop this steadfast heart that leads to a steadfast worship of God? A steadfast heart can only come from a deep trust in God. This trust in God comes from knowing who God is, from knowing what God has done for us, and from knowing the future God has prepared for those who trust in Him. This knowledge can only come from a deep personal study of God’s Word. This is why Paul wrote, Romans 10: 17, “[17] *So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.*” This is why the Hebrew writer reminds us that faith is necessary to please God, Hebrews 11: 6, “[6] *But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.*” This steadfast heart is developed through a deep study of God’s Word. This study should lead us to not only know God’s Word, but it should lead us to trust this Word enough to allow it to help us in our everyday life circumstances. Paul reminds Timothy and us that this knowledge of God’s Word should allow us to come to use it in our everyday life, II Timothy 2: 15 - 16, “[15] *Be diligent to present yourself approved to God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth. [16] But shun profane and idle babblings, for they will increase to more ungodliness.*” This knowledge of God’s Word leads to a trust in God’s Word that helps us make the best of our life’s circumstances. This provides us an anchor to hold us steadfast even during the most difficult of life’s storms, Hebrews 6: 17 - 19, “[17] *Thus God, determining to show more abundantly to the heirs of promise the immutability of His counsel, confirmed it by an oath, [18] that by two immutable things, in which it is impossible for God to lie, we might have strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold of the hope set before us. [19] This hope we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and steadfast, and which enters the Presence behind the veil.*”

This steadfast heart leads us to want to do all that God requires of us. One the most special and precious things that God seeks from us is worship, John 4: 23 - 24, “[23] *But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him. [24] “God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth.”* Having a steadfast heart means we will have a steadfast worship. A steadfast worship means we are looking forward to every opportunity we have to approach God in praise and in admiration for what He has done for us. Both Paul and David through their steadfast hearts learned that this consistence is important to God and should be important to us. Notice how Paul put this in I Corinthians 15: 58, “[58] *Therefore, my beloved brethren, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your labor is not in vain in the Lord.*”

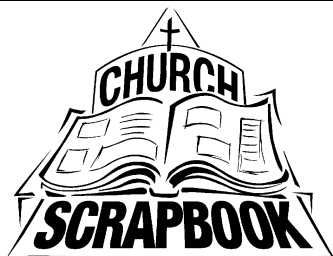
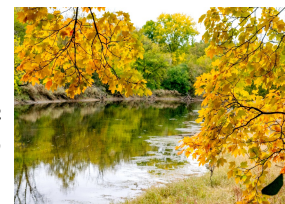

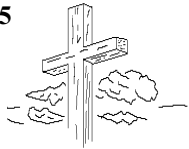
