

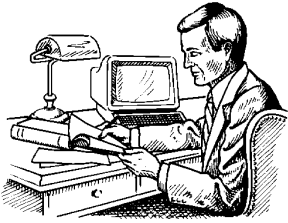

From Where I Sit . . .

“HOW DO YOU VIEW YOUR LIFE?”

How do you view your life? Most of us want our lives to be filled with success and meaning. Yet most of us will evaluate our success and meaning based upon what we have accomplished. We will not deem our lives to be successful or meaningful unless we accomplish some great feat that mankind will deem to be a success. We think that we have to accomplish something grand that will be noticed by men. We want so desperately for others to notice what we have done and to not it as being special. The wise man, Solomon, also thought this was the only way to be successful by meeting the world’s standard of success. Yet, Solomon did not find success nor meaning in these things. Yes, he had power, he had prestige, he had a position, he had riches, and he had everything the world could offer at his finger tips. Notice what Solomon said about these things, Ecclesiastes 12: 8, “[8] *“Vanity of vanities,” says the Preacher, “All is vanity.”* Solomon came to the knowledge that all these things are simply meaningless.

So what is true success? How are we to look at our lives? True success comes from changing who we are. True success comes from destroying an old man of sin, for we are all sinners before God, Romans 3: 23, “[23] *for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.*” Sin takes us away from what God intended for us to be. We were created in God’s own image, Genesis 1: 26 - 28, “[26] *Then God said, “Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth.” [27] So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them. [28] Then God blessed them, and God said to them, “Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth.”* We can never be truly successful until we return to the image that God created us to be. We begin this process of change by hearing the word of God that is to convict us of sin and of righteousness and of judgment. When we come to believe the word of God concerning His Son, we realize that we must believe in Him enough to confess Him before men, Romans 10: 10, “[10] *For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.*” This belief and this confession should motivate us to change the direction of our life in repentance, if we do not make this change we will die in our sins, Luke 13: 3, “[3] *“I tell you, no; but unless you repent you will all likewise perish.”* We must now get back to the image in which we were created, we do this by being born again through baptism, Romans 6: 4 - 10, “[4] *Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life. [5] For if we have been united together in the likeness of His death, certainly we also shall be in the likeness of His resurrection, [6] knowing this, that our old man was crucified with Him, that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves of sin. [7] For he who has died has been freed from sin. [8] Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with Him, [9] knowing that Christ, having been raised from the dead, dies no more. Death no longer has dominion over Him. [10] For the death that He died, He died to sin once for all; but the life that He lives, He lives to God.* “ Now that we have returned to the image God created us to be, we can begin the pursuit of success.

True success begins with a pursuit of becoming like Jesus. Paul put it this way in Galatians 2: 20, “[20] *“I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.”* John said a successful life is walking in fellowship with Jesus, I John 1: 5 - 7, “[5] *This is the message which we have heard from Him and declare to you, that God is light and in Him is no darkness at all. [6] If we say that we have fellowship with Him, and walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth. [7] But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin.*

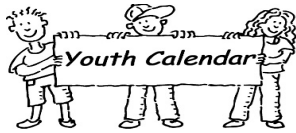

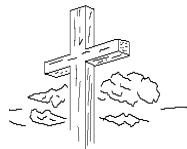
