### *From Where I Sit . . .*

#### *“THE UNSEEN POWER OF GOD”*

Many things in this life can present situations that seem to be overwhelming. We can sometimes feel the whole world is against us. We can even get so bogged down with these life situations that we seem to lose some of our spirituality. Have you ever looked around you and all you see are problems and enemies in every direction? Unfortunately, most of us have experienced periods in our life such as these. If you have not experienced such life circumstances, brace yourself, they are probably coming sooner than later. There are people who face these life situations without fear and without worry. Have you ever wondered how they can do this?

David is one example of a man who found himself in these situations often. He was pursued constantly by King Saul who was using every means possible to destroy David. King Saul had been told by the prophet that David would succeed him as king. Saul thought if he eliminated David, he would eliminate the threat to his throne. David also defeated many armies in battle thus they certainly wanted to extract their revenge upon David for these losses. David even had enemies of those in his own household who wanted to kill him. Notice what David said about this in Psalms 3: 1 - 6, “[3:1] *Lord, how they have increased who trouble me! Many are they who rise up against me. [2] Many are they who say of me, “There is no help for him in God.” Selah [3] But You, O LORD, are a shield for me, My glory and the One who lifts up my head. [4] I cried to the LORD with my voice, And He heard me from His holy hill. Selah [5] I lay down and slept; I awoke, for the LORD sustained me. [6] I will not be afraid of ten thousands of people Who have set themselves against me all around.*”

How could David possibly face all these enemies without fear? David knew something that we all need to come to know. David knew that his faith in God, his obedience to God, and his service to God would bring him to have a relationship with God. This relationship would mean that God would always be with him. He could see the unseen power of God like Elisha in II Kings 6: 15 - 17, “[15] *And when the servant of the man of God arose early and went out, there was an army, surrounding the city with horses and chariots. And his servant said to him, “Alas, my master! What shall we do?” [16] So he answered, “Do not fear, for those who are with us are more than those who are with them.” [17] And Elisha prayed, and said, “LORD, I pray, open his eyes that he may see.” Then the LORD opened the eyes of the young man, and he saw. And behold, the mountain was full of horses and chariots of fire all around Elisha.*” Those who see only the enemies they have in this world, do not see the invisible strength of the Creator that is with them.

Can we be assured God is with us? God has promised to His children that are faithful to Him that He is always with them. Notice Hebrews 13: 5 - 6, “[5] *Let your conduct be without covetousness; be content with such things as you have. For He Himself has said, “I will never leave you nor forsake you.” [6] So we may boldly say: “The LORD is my helper; I will not fear. What can man do to me?”* The Lord is not only with us, but we can count on Him to help us. Also notice Romans 8: 37 - 39, “[37] *Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us. [38] For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, [39] nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.*” Not only is He with us, but He will not allow anything to separate us from Him. He has the power and the willingness to help us overcome anything we fear here on this earth, Ephesians 2: 20 - 21, “[20] *Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us, [21] to Him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus to all generations, forever and ever. Amen.*” To be able to face our difficulties and our enemies without fear, we must see the power and the strength of the unseen. We must love and trust God.

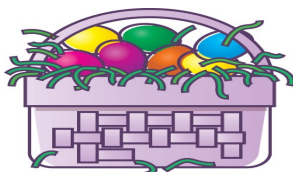

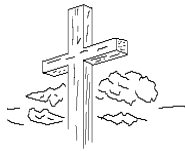
