- If you do not have communion emblems for this Lord's Day, either come by the office during work hours, or call and we will deliver them to you. We passed out a 2-week supply last Friday, but you can use the same procedure to get emblems for the April 5 service.

- Our work for the Lord goes on, even during this shut down time. Our Missionaries, orphans, and other works still need supporting, and the expenses of conducting our work at home continue right on. Our weekly offering is both an expression of our love for God, and a means of supporting all of these efforts. If you do your banking online, you can also use that means of notifying your bank that you want your specified amount to be withdrawn from your account and mailed to the Broad Street Church. This method will delay the offering by approximately one week.

God's Grace Is Amazing

Amazing grace, how sweet the sound, that saved a wretch like me. I once was lost, but now I'm found: was blind, but now I see.

It is truly regrettable and tragic that something so wonderful as the grace of our loving God should be so grossly misunderstood by the religious world. Let us briefly note some facts concerning Jehovah's marvelous grace.

First, the grace of God is universally available to the human family through His Son. *"For the grace of God that bringeth salvation hath appeared to all men."* (Titus 2:11) Indeed, our creator is *"not willing that any should perish."* (II Peter 3:9) And that is why He bade us to preach the gospel to every creature throughout all nations (Matthew 28:19; Mark 16:15).

Secondly, the Bible clearly teaches that the Lord's grace is conditional. In the Old Testament it is revealed that Noah's salvation from the destruction of the flood was due to the fact that he *"found grace in the eyes of Jehovah."* (Genesis 6:22) Obedience to our Maker does not in any sense mean that we merited salvation. But is does mean that we are willing recipients of His favor.

But thirdly, if it is to avail, the grace of God must be continued in. On the first missionary journey, in Antioch of Pisidia, Paul and Barnabas urged those who had been responsive to their preaching to *"continue in the grace of God."* (Acts 13:43) It is possible to *"receive the grace of God"* in vain (II Cor. 6:1); to fall away therefrom (Galatians 5:4), and thus to be severed from Christ and lost. May it not be so in our case.

A youth and an old man talked one day. Said the boy, "I think I'll go aw ay From Father's old farm..don't know just when." The old man listened and asked, "What then?"


"I guess I'll have some fun in town The first few years...then settle down And get a job and earn a lot." The old man smiled and asked, "Then w hat?"


